What should I bring?

Required:

How can I get help?

Please **do not**:

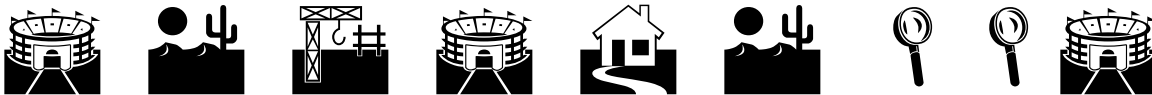
